



Jamison High School

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Dear Parents and Caregivers,

We have been working through the phased return for Jamison High School students over the past week and have a plan for the safe and sustainable return to school for our community. We have catered for the phased return of all students, with a particular focus on Year 12 to ensure they meet requirements for the awarding of the Higher School Certificate.

The information that follows shows the finer detail of our phased return model. We have based our planning on the *NSW Department of Education Managed return to school guidelines for families* which has been reproduced on the following page. This model could operate for the rest of the Term, or it could be upscaled (or downscaled) to accommodate other phases in the return of students to school. This will ensure that we can support the sustained learning of our students in the uncertain term ahead.

Online Learning

In this phased return it needs to be noted that across all phases students engage with a single unit of work and we anticipate that the bulk of learning for Term 2 will be online. It is important that students have access to a device at home as well as when they attend school so that they can complete the learning activities. This is to ensure that students, if they are at school or at home, have access to the same units of work.

Weeks 1 and 2 of Term 2

In line with the Premier's direction, we are operating in Phase 0 for the first two weeks of term. All curriculum is being delivered online through Google Classroom and Adobe Connect sessions to support the majority of our students working from home. This model will continue to operate even as we transition to students attending one day per week.

Weeks 3 and 4 of Term 2

From Week 3, Monday May 11 we will have at least one year group onsite every day. Year 7 will be attending school on Thursday, Year 8 on Friday, Year 9 on Monday and Year 10 on Tuesday. Support students will attend on particular days, according to their class. Year 11 will operate on a new timetable on Wednesday, consisting of 6 x 45 minute periods. We have restructured the day to ensure that Year 11 attend each subject once per week. Year 12 will be attending on Thursday and Friday from Week 3 and operate on a changed timetable. In addition, Year 12 students completing major works will be able to access the school on Wednesdays to work on their projects with their teachers. Further details of days of attendance and timetable changes are in the tables that follow. Year 7 – 10 operate on their usual Week A and B timetable for the days they attend in Week 3 and 4.

When students return we will implement social distancing measures in line with Department requirements to ensure the safety of staff and students. Hand sanitiser will be located in all classrooms and we will increase the supply of soap in our toilets for the return of students. We currently have enhanced cleaning operating at the school and understand that from Week 3 there will be additional cleaning during school hours of high touch surfaces.

Further correspondence will be provided as we add in more detail around this phased return to school. To ensure the safety of our community we ask that at this time parents refer all enquires to the school via phone and that you do not congregate at the school gate or car parks when students return.

PHASE 0

Schools are open for families who need it.

- Schools are safe places for students, teachers and staff.
- All students engage with a single unit of work.
- Keep up-to-date with your school's communications to make sure you receive important messages about timetable changes.
- Any identified cases of COVID-19 will continue to be managed in line with health advice, including temporary school closures where necessary.

PHASE 1

Students at school at least one day per week.

- Families are encouraged to keep their children at home wherever possible, with no student to be turned away.
- Students who attend school are supervised only, not in their regular classes.
- No excursions or inter-school activities.
- Continued enhanced cleaning and hygiene supply arrangements.

PHASE 2

Students at school at least two days per week.

- Schools have discretion for establishing which group attends on which day, with a preference to group siblings/families together.
- Families who need to send their child to school every day may continue to do so and no child will be turned away.
- Classes are split across different spaces and break times can be staggered.
- No excursions or inter-school activities.
- Continued enhanced cleaning and hygiene supply arrangements.

PHASE 3

Students at school five days per week, with social distancing measures.

- Schools have discretion for establishing which group attends on which days, with a preference to group siblings/families together.
- Families who need to send their child to school every day may continue to do so and no child will be turned away.
- Classes are split across different spaces and break times can be staggered.
- No excursions or inter-school activities.
- Continued enhanced cleaning and hygiene supply arrangements.

PHASE 4

Students at school five days per week, with full school activities.

- Students with increased health risks may continue to learn at home to suit their individual needs.
- Students remain in the same classroom for the day, break times can be staggered to reduce mixing between class groups.
- No excursions or inter-school activities.
- Continued enhanced cleaning and hygiene supply arrangements.

You can now

- Send your child/children to school every day.
- Participate in school excursions and inter-school activities.
- Use playground equipment at schools.
- Drop your child/children off at school as you would normally do.
- Participate in school based activities such as volunteering in classes and assemblies.
- Use services that usually operate at your school like canteens and other community run activities.

You can now

- Send your child/children to school every day.
- Access community services run on school sites, where they are not restricted by Public Health Orders.
- Use the school canteen and uniform shop where appropriate hygiene measures are in place.
- Walk your child/children into and out of school while maintaining social distancing.

You can now

- Send your child/children to school two days a week.
- You are encouraged to keep your child at home for the rest of the week wherever possible.
- Check with your school to see which two days of the week your child/children should attend.
- Use the school canteen and uniform shop where appropriate hygiene measures are in place.

You can now

- Send your child/children to school one day a week.
- You are encouraged to keep your child at home for the rest of the week wherever possible.

You must continue to

- Keep your child/children at home if possible.
- Support your child/children to continue learning at home.
