Planning continues for a new multi-purpose hall at Jamison High School. The project includes:

- A new school hall facility.
- Indoor sports courts.
- Sports and large equipment storage rooms.
- New toilets and back of house facilities.

Progress summary

Planning of the new hall project continues. Early works have enabled us to achieve an understanding of the requirements of the school.

The schematic design is now complete School Infrastructure NSW (SINSW) has completed the tender process to construct the new multi-purpose hall.

The construction contract has been awarded to Prime Constructions and we expect construction to start soon with the aim of completing the hall in late 2021, subject to planning approvals.

Next steps

- Continue development application process.
- Continue Project Reference Group (PRG) meetings.
- Contractor will start site establishment work.
