## Footwear Requirements

When purchasing school shoes parents are asked to be mindful of NSW Department of Education and Training, Occupational Health & Safety requirements regarding footwear. This requirement states that all students involved in practical activities in subject areas including Creative Arts, Industrial Arts, Home Economics, and Science must wear: **“shoes with fully enclosed firm leather uppers, including the tongue, and a stout non-slip sole”**.

This requirement is satisfied through the purchase of black leather, lace up school shoes as per the school’s uniform policy. **Rabens, vans, volleys, converse, skate style shoes, canvas style shoes, gym boots and ballet flats do not provide adequate protection and are therefore not acceptable.**

Students who present themselves to classes without the correct footwear will not be permitted to participate in practical activities.

### ACCEPTABLE FOOTWEAR

**Black leather lace up footwear** with fully enclosed uppers, including the tongue and a stout non-slip sole.



### UNACCEPTABLE FOOTWEAR

Unacceptable footwear includes joggers, gym boots, volleys, skate shoes and ballet flats
